INSTRUCTIONS

FABRIC REQUIRED

1 x FQ Guards/Green
1 x FQ Phone Box/Grey
1 x FQ Phone Box/Gold
1 x FQ London Bus/Grey
1 x FQ London Bus/Gold
1 x LQ Union-Flag or Union Flag/Taxis
50cm Dark Grey/Black Marble effect
60cm Contrasting red for Sashing/Border

1.10 metre London Icons for backing

25cm London Taxis for Binding

44" square cotton batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

cut 1 x 8" Square
cut 2 x 8" Square
cut 2 x 8" Square
cut 2 x 8" Square
cut 2 x 8" Square
cut 4 x 42" x 3
cut 18 pieces 10.5" x 3"
cut 6 pieces 3" x 10.5"
cut 4 pieces 3" x 35.5"
cut 2 pieces 3 x 40.5"

cut to size required before Binding
(approx 42" square)

cut 4 strips using full width of the fabric,
each 2" x 44"



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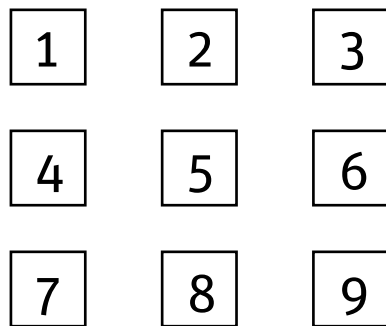
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PIECING INSTRUCTIONS - All piecing allows for $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams

1 - Take each of the 8" squares and add the grey/black marble effect to 'frame the feature fabric at the left and lower edges. Either mitre the corners or attach one strip to the left edge first then strip along the base.

Lay the 9 blocks out in the positions you want them to be in the finished quilt. Use sticker or coloured pin to number the blocks 1 - 9 in rows across:



2 - Horizontal Sashing

Arrange the blocks in sets of 3; (1, 4 and 7), (2, 5, and 8) and (3, 6 and 9).

Attach a red piece (3 x 10.5) to the bottom of blocks 1 and 4, 2 and 5, 3 and 6.

Join 1, 4 and 7 to make a column. repeat for 2, 5 and 8, and then for 3, 6 and 9.

3 - Vertical Sashing

Using the red strips (3 x 35.5), attach one red strip between columns 1 and 2, and one between 2 and 3.

4 - Border

Join the two remaining long strips (3 x 35.5) to the outside edges onto columns 1 and 3.

Join the last two long red strips (3 x 40.5) to the top of the quilt top and one to the bottom.

5 - Layer up, Quilt and Binding

Using the London Icons on the back of the quilt, layer up with cotton batting and quilt by hand or machine. I have simply quilted in the ditch around each feature fabric and along the sashing. Trim backing and batting to fit quilt top and add the binding.

I attached the binding strips to the front (right sides together) and then flipped the binding over to the back and hand stitched to finish.
